“Echoes Theatre Company” presented Sophocles’ major play “Antigone” in original ancient Greek text, with respect to the musical design the poet conceived.

All main characters (Antigone, her sister Ismene, King Kreon, his son Aemon, soothsayer Teiresias) as well as Chorus (consisted by distinguished elderly Lords of Thebes), were interpreted by two performers on stage (one actor and one musician), who explored their full physical potential in order to achieve necessary differentiations of roles. Additionally, choral songs were executed according to the original metrical-rhythmical sets of verses designed thoroughly by Sophocles himself.
